FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the difference between this contracting vehicle and other government contracting vehicles?

A GSA schedule contract identifies the products and services offered by a contractor for sale to the federal government through the program at the prices, terms and conditions agreed upon by the contractor and GSA. Thus, agencies make purchases directly from the company holding the contract.

How much will GSA charge for using the schedule?

GSA charges a $\frac{3}{4}$ of 1% industrial funding fee on all GSA schedule sales.

Is there an ordering limit when using the GSA schedule?

There is no maximum ordering limit for each contractor. However, there is a maximum threshold amount that applies, depending on the services provided.

Am I getting the "best price" for my products and services by using the schedule?

GSA has already determined that rates and services contained on a contractor's price list are deemed to be fair and reasonable.

Who is eligible to purchase off of the GSA schedule?

- All buying members of GSA Order ADM 4800.2D, which includes all federal, DoD and civilian agencies.
- Other federal agencies.
- Mixed-ownership government corporations and the District of Columbia.
- Government contractors authorized by 48 CFR 51.1.
- Other activities and organizations authorized by statute or regulation to use GSA as a source of supply.
- State and local governments, for certain types of purchases only.
