Northern and Southern Guam Reservoirs Design

Guam

The island is undergoing a massive reconstruction effort of its water system infrastructure to overcome years of suffering mother nature's worst and to handle an ever-increasing civilian and military population. The governing agency that owns, operates, and maintains the water system has called on the expertise of Michael Baker to deliver multiple projects.

P-270 Aviation Combat Element Gym and Dining Facility

Joint Region Marianas - Andersen Air Force Base, Guam

Provided architectural and engineering services for a combined Dining Facility and High Intensity Tactical Training (HITT) fitness/gym facility, and a separate utility building for mechanical equipment and a back-up electrical generator. The team provided architecture, landscape architecture, interior design, plumbing, telecommunications, and structural, fire protection, electrical, civil, and mechanical engineering for this project. These plans are critical to future bilateral negotiations and will allow effective and economical decision-making concerning infrastructure modernization and relocation.



Repair of Runway 05L/23R Conceptual Charrette Report & DD1391

Kadena Air Base, Okinawa, Japan

The project goal is to develop a strategy to optimize future utilization and facility investment in the primary runway. It is comprised of asphalt and PCC pavements and contains various associated electrical infrastructure and supporting, including limited in-pavement touch-down zone and edge lighting, as well as being supported by an approach lighting system and an instrument and visual approaches systems. The runway has 12 separate taxiway connectors and four separate arresting systems. Due to OPSTEMPO, maintaining this runway in its optimal state is paramount.

Repair Misawa Command Post, Building 928

Misawa Air Base, Aomori, Japan

Michael Baker delivered an ahead-of-schedule revitalization design of the installation's critical nerve center. This sustainment design for a 36-year-old facility with no major renovations since declared fully operational, addressed significant concerns with the HVAC, electrical, and fire alarms systems, replacing many major components. These judicious upgrades along with multiple other prudent improvements were carefully designed to incorporate local materials, codes, and construction practices as well as cybersecurity requirements supporting maintainability, operability, and survivability for several decades to come.

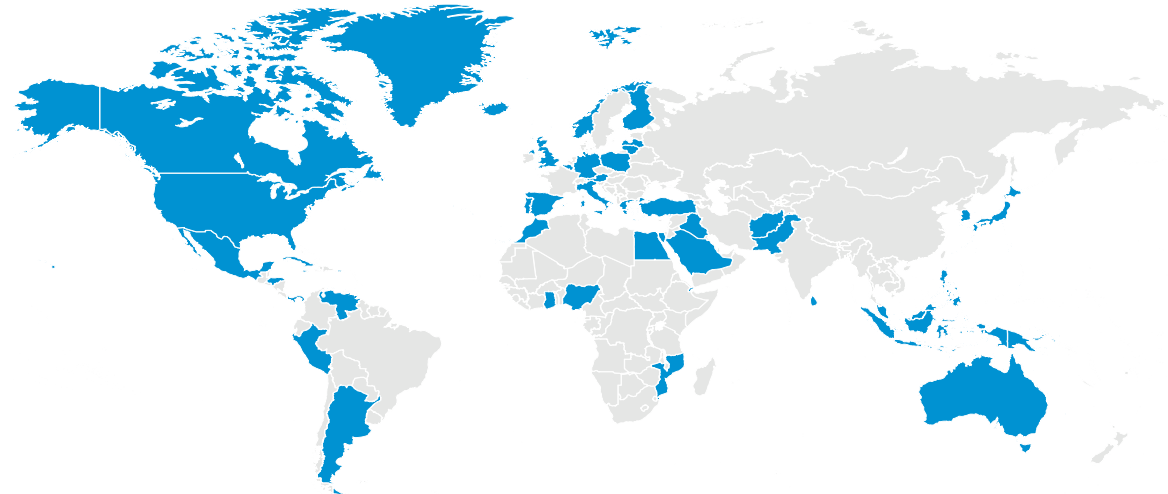
