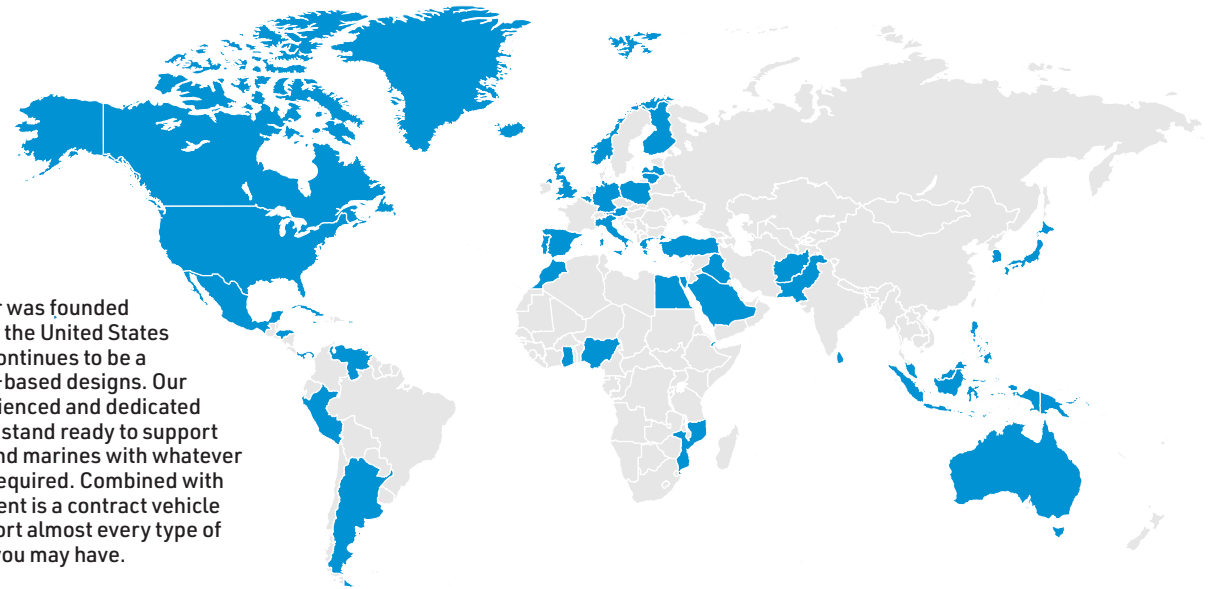

MILCON Preliminary Design Authority (PDA) efforts, to include DD1391 preparation, 35% design, concept sketches, preliminary site plans with building footprint, geotechnical report, site civil survey information and other similar planning and programming-related documents.

Cost estimates; construction contract support services (CCSS) or post construction award services (PCAS); types of projects may include, but are not limited to, new construction, repair, and renovation of the following: wet utility systems (water, wastewater, recycled, and stormwater); airfield pavement including runways, taxiways, and aprons; roads and paving; bridges; entry gates/control points; outdoor recreational fields; outdoor shooting and combat training ranges; erosion control, stormwater management, and low impact development design; and other related work.

Technical reviews of government-prepared RFP for DB projects and/or full plans and specifications for DBB projects; preparation of planning and programming support documents (such as DD1391 documents); incidental architectural, structural, geotechnical, mechanical, electrical, and environmental work; identification and abatement methods for existing asbestos-containing materials, lead-based paint, and other hazardous materials.
